## Program enrolments by age group



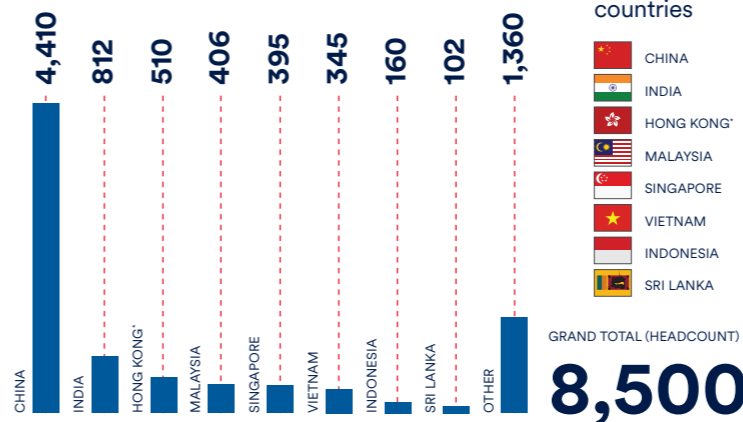

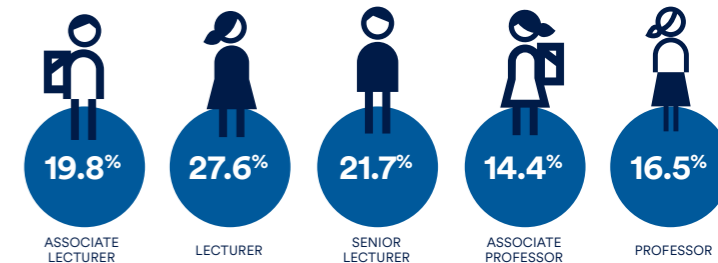

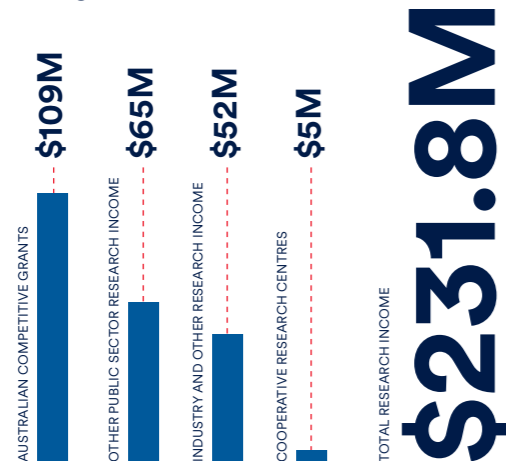
