HISTORY

Arthur and Ruth Tideman chose a Small Homes Service designed house (Plan AC 301) for their home in 1959. It was built by Classic Construction at 32 (later renumbered as 42) Adelaide Street, Magill. They donated material relating to this house to the Architecture Museum in 2007.
