Can OUA students apply for an Internal Transfer?	<p>Yes</p> <p>If students are admitted and actively enrolled in one of the OUA online undergraduate award programs</p>
Who is responsible for Internal Transfer Applications?	<p>University of Adelaide</p> <p>OUA students who wish to transfer their studies to a different UofA program, can apply to do so via the Admission at Adelaide system. They must meet the relevant criteria and understand that the majority of programs offered by the University are only offered as an on-campus experience. Applications are assessed and approved by Domestic Admissions.</p>

Key Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can a student in an online program, transfer into an on-campus program? This scenario, or vice versa, is possible though may not be likely as a student chooses an online program because that's their preferred mode of study. However, it may be the case that a face-to-face student suddenly realises they could study online and chooses to swap or vice versa, lives in Adelaide and wishes to have an on-campus experience.• Can a student in a face-to-face program, transfer into an online program? If student is currently in a face-to-face program and wants to transfer to an online program, they would need to apply via Open Universities Australia (OUA) and would still need to satisfy the four (4) core Open Access pathway course requirements to be eligible to be admitted into one of the online undergraduate programs.
