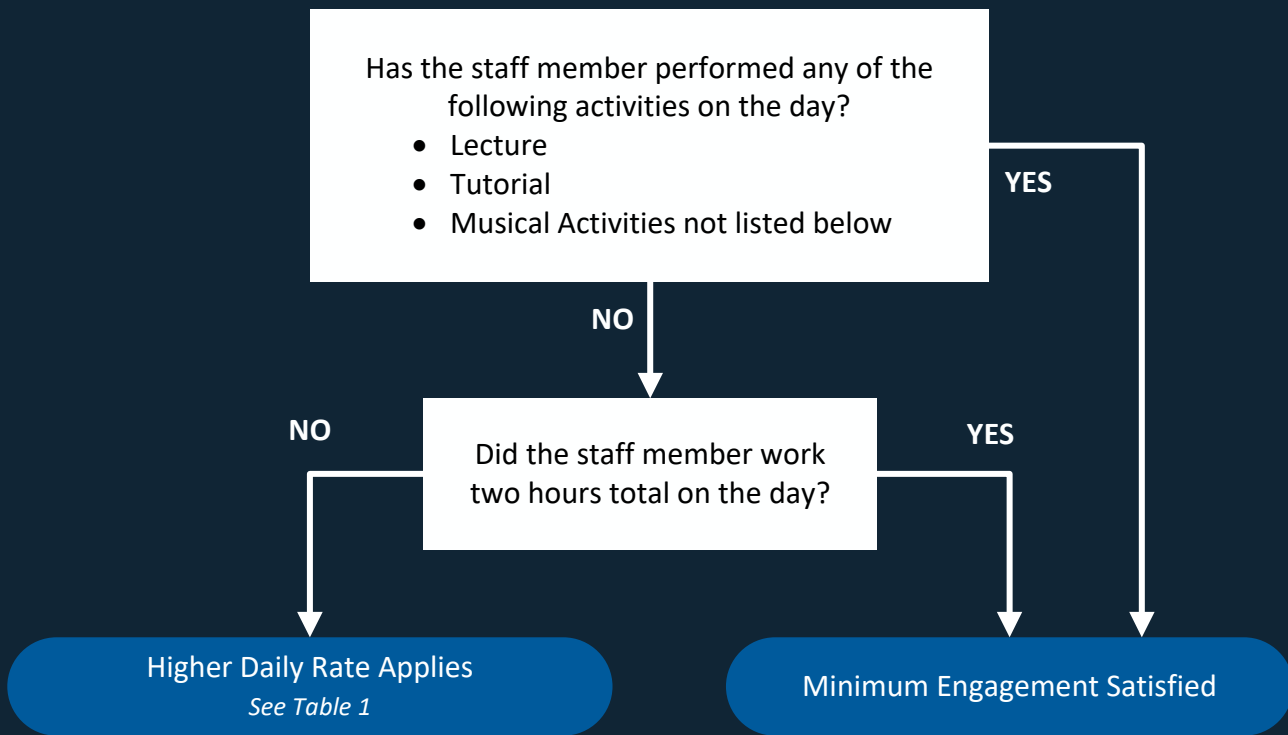


Casual Academic Minimum Engagement Decision Tree



Example

Joan is a casual academic who has been engaged by the University to hold a 1-hour workshop on Tuesday. They are not required to do any other work on that day, so will fill out their timesheet for 1 hour of work. As Joan has been engaged to work less than 2 hours over the course of the day, instead of being paid 1 hour of “Other Required Academic Activity” which attracts a rate of \$53.13, they will be paid \$83.42 for the day.

Table 1: Casual Academic <2 Hour Engagement Rates

Activity	EA Rate	Top Up Amount	Total Daily Rate*
Other Required Academic Activity	\$53.13	\$30.29	\$83.42
Other Required Academic Activity (PhD/Course Coordination)	\$63.19	\$31.55	\$94.74
Marking (Standard)	\$53.13	\$30.29	\$83.42
Marking (PhD/Course Coordination)	\$63.19	\$31.55	\$94.74
Marking (High Level – Supervising Examiner)	\$73.78	\$33.21	\$106.99
Music Auditioning	\$53.13	\$30.29	\$83.42
Practical examining	\$73.78	\$33.21	\$106.99

**This rate applies only when it exceeds the amount the staff member would earn on the day based on their actual hours worked.*
