

EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR SELT AGGREGATE REPORT

These reports contain aggregate results of the SELT (Student Experience of Learning and Teaching) course surveys (including teacher questions) conducted for the academic year.

Please note the following:

- 1. These reports contain collated statistical results for SELT surveys only for this reporting period, and are based only on the information in the SELT (Course and Teacher questions) conducted at the end of each Semester, Trimester or Term.
- 2. These reports provide aggregated SELT survey response results for each of the 9 COURSE LIKERT QUESTIONS or 6 STANDARD TEACHER LIKERT QUESTIONS. Response statistics for each academic level (Faculty or School) where responses were received are shown for each question. The results are based on the analysis of the raw Likert response scores (excluding N/A) for each course and teacher.

Explanation of Terms:

All Responses

The number of student responses per question received for all course SELTs including N/A.

Responses

The number of student responses per question received for all course SELTs which had a Likert response score of between 1 and 7 for each question. Excluding responses of N/A.

N/A

The number of student responses per question received for all course SELTs where the student selected N/A. These responses have been excluded from all statistical calculations.

Mean

The mean score of all Responses received for the question.

StDev

The standard deviation of all Responses for the question.

Median

The Likert score of the middle of the sample. Score at which 50% of student responses were below.

% BA

Broad Agreement (% of student responses between 5 and 7 or 'in agreement').
