Adelaide Compliance and Ethics System

(ACES) is used at the University of Adelaide for Animal Ethics applications, Human Ethics applications, Biosecurity and Gene Technology applications.

What is ACES?

ACES enables applicants to:

- Draft and submit a brand-new application in the following areas:
 - Gene Technology/Regulated Biological Materials
 - Human ethics
 - Animal ethics
- Amend an existing application
- Duplicate an existing application
- Transferring an application to another user

Do I need to apply for access to ACES?

All existing University of Adelaide academic and professional staff, research students, affiliates, conjoints and adjuncts will automatically be granted access to the platform. No registration is required. You can log in by clicking on the University Login button on the login page.

External users: If you are an external user (collaborator), please contact the relevant Research Ethics Officer who will set you up with an account:

Logging in


Log in using your University of Adelaide email address and password. If you have problems logging in, you may need to clear your cache.
