

## International Student Support Invitation Letter Information

This form is intended as a guide for international students who are writing invitation letters. It is intended as a general guide only.

If your family members apply for a visitor visa to visit you in Australia, they may need to provide an invitation letter. This invitation letter is a letter from you (not from the University) that explains your relationship to your family member and the reason that you are inviting them to visit you in Australia.

Information that you may wish to include in your invitation letter:

- > The names and dates of birth of the relatives you are inviting
- > Your relatives' intended travel dates
- > An explanation of your student status and program of study
- > An explanation of the reason that you are inviting your relatives
- > Graduation ceremony dates (if your relatives are visiting to attend your graduation)
