

## 2024 Information Sheet for Students

The Q Fever vaccination is a requirement for the majority of programs within the School of Animal and Veterinary Sciences (SAVS). Please refer to SAVS [Guidelines for vaccinations](#) for more information.

### Q Fever Providers

To register take these two forms ([Consent](#) & [Pre-Screening](#)) with you to your medical practitioner.

### Cost

All costs associated with testing and vaccination must be paid for by the student. The cost of testing and vaccinations vary from provider to provider (ranging from approximately \$220 to \$500). The consultation fee at a GP may be covered by Medicare and the vaccination may be covered by some private health insurance companies. Students are advised to consult their private health insurance provider regarding associated costs with vaccines.

### Preferred Providers

The School has connections with three clinics that are willing to take a group of students and as a result the cost is reduced (see below). In 2024 we have organised Group Vaccination Clinics REFER TO PAGE 2 for dates and how to book in.
